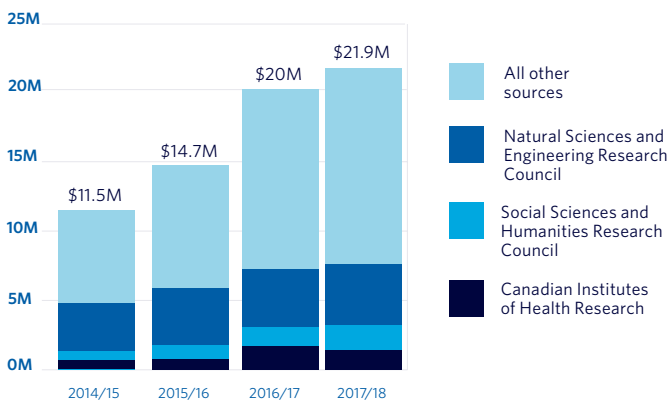


Research Excellence

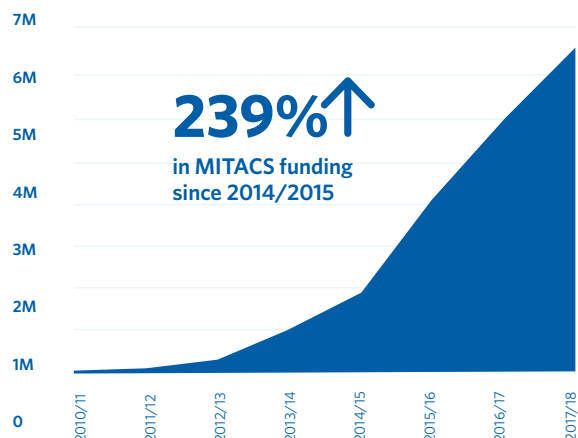

TOTAL RESEARCH FUNDING

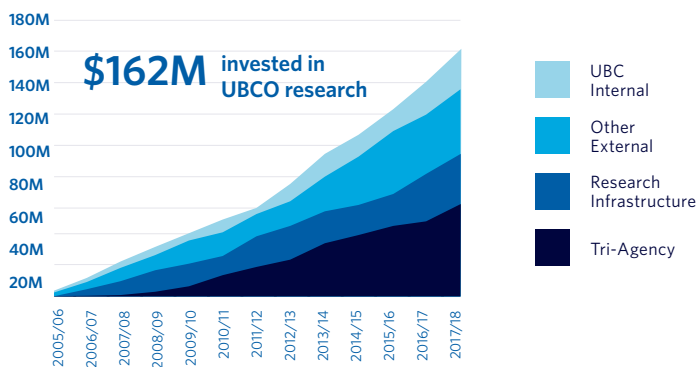

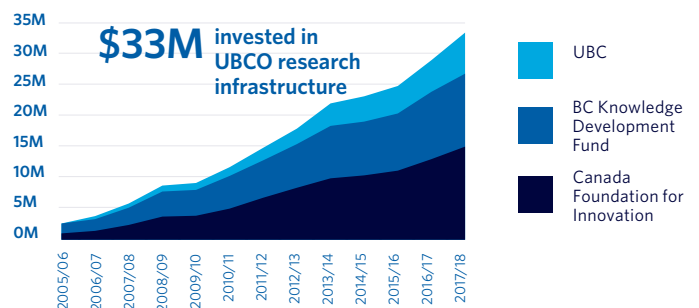
CUMULATIVE MITACS FUNDING

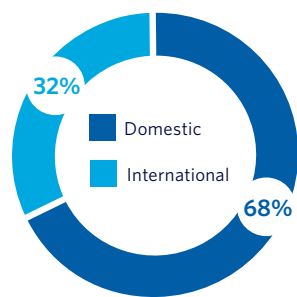
